Formal Admission

All students must submit a copy of their secondary (or highest) diploma, degree, or transcript.

- *Transfer credit* may be considered only upon receipt of official transcripts.
- *Admission to a master's program* may be granted upon receipt of a transcript or diploma that indicates you hold a 4 year bachelor's degree with a 3.00 or better Grade Point Average.

Getting Started

The first recommended course is BRS 16.6 course (A Search for Spirituality) for undergraduates or for graduate students, MRS 622 (A Search for Spirituality). This course requires no additional resources, can be completed within a short period of time, and requires the student to engage in analytical thinking.

1. Go to www.nationsu.org.
2. Click on **Students/NU Courses** box on the left side of the page.
3. Login with username and password on right side of page (you received these codes upon registration).
4. **Undergraduates** choose "Religious Studies Core." These are the required courses.
Graduates choose "Required for a Master's Degree."
5. Click the icon,  to the right of the first course and read **course summary** and introduction.
6. Click on your first course: **A Search for Spirituality (BRS 16.6 or MRS 622)**
7. Click Yes to enroll for the first time in the course. Read carefully the course summary, procedure, and all introductory materials.
8. Before beginning Module 1, take the time to complete the Spiritual Inventory.
9. Study carefully Module one and use of the Study Guide found on the homepage in the Student Tutorial under Current Students.
10. When fully prepared for the exam, find the link shown just under the Module (ex: BRS 16.6-1D)
11. You will have a time limit to answer a set of multiple-choice questions.
12. Click Submit All and Finish at the end of the exam.

Exam Scores

Scores are posted within 4-6 hours and can be viewed online. Click Reports on the left side of the page immediately after Login and look for your User Report. Scroll down to find your course and your score.

If your score is above 70 you have completed the module. Proceed to study module two at any time. If your score is below 70%, you should study the module again, more carefully and re-take the exam.

After the completion of your first course, continue with the list of courses outlined on your personal user report.
