NationsUniversity is pleased that you would consider recommending the school to those who are incarcerated. To that end, we have conveniently placed appropriate materials on the Internet that you can print and distribute.

We do request that you distribute materials in a discriminate manner. The most successful NationsUniversity students are those who fully understand the nature of NU courses and are committed to study.

Below are suggestions for recruiting and guiding potential students.

- NationsUniversity courses/exams are college level. They are intended for the person who is searching for a program that can potentially lead to a college degree. Admission is granted to those with the equivalent of a high school diploma.
- NationsUniversity programs are designed for the person who wants to engage in religious studies. NU does not offer a degree in any other field.
- NationsUniversity programs function best when the prospective student is a person of special interest. This means that you are willing to assume responsibility for transferring the student's registration into an electronic registration—you actually register the student directly on NationsUniversity's website. Additionally, you are willing to encourage the student during his/her studies and to proctor his/her examinations. Proctors are expected to receive and administer student's exams and returns answers to NU for grading.

*The procedure outlined above is optimum. However, NU will service students who learn about us second and third hand through the passing on of a brochure and independent mail-in registration.*
